

GCARES Playbook for 2020 SET:

1. ASEC will be alerting EC/registered county of a situation.
2. Members will receive a HyperReach message instructing them to the XWARN repeater (147.1650+ 123.0 Hz tone) for more info and to check-in with their availability. Bob (N8ADO) has the DARA truck and will be running that net.
3. You will be asked at check-in if you are a new amateur (defined as licensed since 2016) and if you will be running on emergency power.
4. Once checked-in, operators will be sent to the Tactical Net GCARES repeater (146.9100- no tone) for assignment. I will be handling NCS for this, but also from the BAT so the net controls can work together. As a side note, Resource NCS will check into District 3 Logistical Net saying we have been activated.
5. As instructed, operators will then join a Google Meets session somewhere representing a Served Agency.
6. Served Agency representatives will provide messages to be relayed.
7. Operators will send messages to the tactical net where Bill will be listening and then sending to Buckeye Net as our Greene County traffic liaison. I'd like to give our ops the opportunity to put it in radiogram form themselves with Fldigi if you have the capability. This will lighten Bill's load a lot. If you choose digital, I will direct you to pass that traffic on GCARES digital band, (MT63 2KL FM) 442.7250+ no tone.
8. Operators will also listen to tactical net for responses from the liaison station and relay them back to the Served Agency representatives.
9. **When an operator's shift is over or they "change locations", they need to check-out from the Tactical Net and then the Resource net.**
